EXECUTIVE

CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION

LEGISLATIVE

INTERNATIONAL SERVICE BOARD (ISB)

Maintains and fosters a relationship of inter-dependence between UAI and Urantia Foundation. UAI maintains an office which is operated by an Executive Administrator.

MEMBERS

President*, Vice-President*, Treasurer*, Secretary*, Charter, Communications* Conference, Dissemination, Education*, Membership*, Study Group, Translation* Executive Committee

TERMS OF OFFICE

All members have 4 year terms, a maximum of 2 consecutive terms, and must be out of office for 2 years before holding another office, terms staggered.

REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL (RC)

The voting members of the RC are the elected Presidents and Vice-Presidents of each National Association. Each member has one vote.

NATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS WITHOUT LOCALS

Each Association must have a minimum of 30 members:

- Australia/New Zealand •Brazil
- Finland •France •México
- Perú •Sénégal •Spain

NATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS WITH LOCALS

Each Local Association has a 10 Member minimum. National has 30-member minimum:

- Canada (3 locals) •Colómbia (4 locals) •United States (26 locals)

JUDICIARY

JUDICIAL COMMISSION

All members have 4 year terms, a maximum of 2 consecutive terms, and must be out of office for 2 years before holding another office, terms staggered.

COMMISSIONERS

Chief Judicial Commissioner*; Judicial Commissioners: Minimum of 3 and a maximum of 7; Elected by RC* First term 4 years

TERMS OF OFFICE

All Commissioners have 6 year terms, maximum of 3 consecutive terms, staggered terms, no more than approximately ½ of seats vacant for election in same year.

LOCAL ASSOCIATIONS (POTENTIAL NATIONAL)

Less than 30 members / Observer to RC Meetings / No Vote on RC:

- Argentina •Chile •Estonia •United Kingdom/Ireland
- Belgium •Sweden

FULL MEMBERS

Must have read *The Urantia Book* in its entirety; has voting privileges; may hold office.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

In process of reading *The Urantia Book*; no voting privileges; may not hold office.

MEMBERS-AT-LARGE

Living in country with no Association or in isolated area; no voting rights.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS-AT-LARGE

In process of reading *The Urantia Book* in a country with no associations or in an isolated area; no voting rights.

ASSOCIATIONS

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

Must have 30 Full Members

LOCAL ASSOCIATION

(NON-NATIONAL)
Potential National Association with less than 30 members

LOCAL ASSOCIATION

Minimum of 10 full members;
Within a National Association.
(US: 26 / Canada: 3 / Colombia: 4)

COMMITTEES

Conference • Education •

TERMS OF OFFICE

Two year terms; maximum of two consecutive terms; one year between terms thereafter.
